

Membership of Senate Committees Resolution 2010-09

Whereas, the Academic Senate is the organization whose primary function is to make recommendations with respect to academic and professional matters as defined in Title 5, Article 2, section 53200; and,

Whereas, Academic Senate committees and councils are the primary means by which the Senate attends to its critical academic and professional responsibilities; and,

Whereas, Academic Senate councils and committees are responsible for a regular review of their purpose, function and membership;

Resolved, the majority of members on all Academic Senate councils and committees shall be faculty members; and,

Resolved, any proposal to add a non-faculty member to an Academic Senate committee or council shall require a written rationale linking the qualifications of the non-faculty position to items on the committee purpose and function statement.
