	Japanese – Proposed Change	<p>Recommended rewording as follows so as to clarify intent: --Master's in a field related to Eastern Asian Studies, language acquisition or education such as East Asian Languages and Cultures, East Asian Studies, Linguistics, Education, Bilingual Education, TESOL, Curriculum & Instruction, or Speech Communication; AND, --A minimum of 12 semester upper division or graduate units in classes related to the study of Japanese Language or Culture; AND, --Fluency in written and spoken Japanese, as determined by the current full time professor(s) of Japanese.</p>	
	Committee Goals	<p>Goal #1 –The committee will communicate the recently adopted procedures on equivalencies and will review & update all equivalencies from 2006 or earlier.</p> <p>Goal #2 – The committee will present a workshop to provide guidelines and examples related to discipline equivalencies.</p> <p>Note: Flex Day has already occurred this year.
