(07/10/2017)</p> <p><b>Reporting Year:</b> 2016-17  <b>% Completed:</b> 100  A survey was administered to Finals Frenzy participants and recipients of Finals Kits/IFAKS which revealed the following:  -93% of survey respondents reported that receiving food/snacks at the VRC during finals week “allowed me to focus more on preparing for finals”.  -80% of survey respondents reported their reason for visiting the VRC during finals week was to study and use the computers.  -100% of survey respondents reported that utilizing the VRC during finals week positively impacted their performance on their finals.  -95% of survey respondents reported that receiving a Finals Kit/IFAK “allowed me to focus more on preparing for finals because I didn’t have to worry about supplies”.
