1. Welcome	Dale welcomed everyone to the meeting. Fawaz Al-Malood and Mark Lowentrout were introduced as new members representing Instruction.	Information only.
2. Review of September 2020 Memory	Reviewed and approved September memory with a minor correction.	The memory is posted to the ITAC website.
3. WebCMS Project Update	Monica Cantu-Chan provided a status of the WebCMS project upgrade. There are two logs for tracking issues. The first log tracks systemic issues that the vendor needs to fix. At the moment, most high priority issues have been resolved. The medium priority issues should be fixed in the next two weeks. The secondary log tracks curriculum support requests that IT or the Office of Instruction responds to and closes. Requests for assistance can be submitted from the form at the WebCMS 10.0 site located at <a href="https://www.mtsac.edu/webcms/">https://www.mtsac.edu/webcms/</a> . Monica reported that the WebCMS interface drastically changed from version 1.0 to 10.0. Training is critical to learn navigation in the new tool. The 1.0 version site will continue to live for one year. Many users need to update their bookmarks to the new website address.  Jai and Jean expressed how frustrated faculty are with the new system. They don't find it to be user-friendly. There have been unexplained system errors with curriculum moving through the wrong stages only to have it sent back to faculty to re-do.
