1. Welcome	Dale welcomed everyone to the meeting.	Information only.
2. Review of June 2018 Minutes	Minutes were approved.	Minutes will be posted to the ITAC website.
3. IT Summer Project Update A. Construction B. Preferred Name Implementation C. Banner 9	Ron gave an update on various construction projects that are affecting IT. The stadium project is under construction and moving rapidly. A proposed parking structure with tennis courts will be completed if the new bond measure is passed. Building 16E, along Miracle Mile, is scheduled to be completed this calendar year with Counselors occupying it by December. Future projects that IT is currently involved in specifications meetings are the Student Center, Library, MakerSpace, and Transportation Center. The committee discussed the timeline for the various projects, the technology that will be included, and the projects that will need new bond funding to move forward.  Dale discussed the implementation of a new feature for students to input their preferred name. This new feature went live right before the start of fall semester. From inside the portal, students click a link and are brought to a self-service screen to enter their preferred name. This name is shown on the faculty roster only. It is not populated in other areas of Banner. There is no intention to expand this project to display the preferred name in other locations. 4. Technology Master Plan	verifying a student's ID number is the best way to verify their identity when the preferred name and legal name may be different. Dale shared that we will be moving to Banner 9 effective October 15, 2018. IT is offering training sessions via POD on the new Banner 9 interface. This is a major interface change, but the functionality of the system will remain the same. Dale also reminded the committee that Lotus Notes access will be eliminated as of January 1, 2019.
