A goal was set for sub-teams to finish placement formulas by mid to late October 2016. 2.3 Discussion took place regarding range of placements. If 70% of the chosen competencies are met, students will be placed in that course. Students at CSUSB self-place into courses, but they have 2.2 Next SSSPAC and CAI access to detailed course information and Implementation meeting is scheduled for May 25, 2016 assignments. A suggestion was made to use professional judgment to determine a range of 2.3 D. 5. Multiple Measures Data	5.1 From March – May 2015, 57.7% of students were taking multiple measures. From June-August 2015, 76% of students were taking multiple measures. From Decembers 2015-March 1, 2016, 80% of students were taking multiple measures. It is possible that many of these students may be taking the test at their high schools and may not have claimed their Mt. SAC accounts to access their portals in order to take the MMs. Several members of SSSPAC were highly concerned that high school students are being placed with out MMs and agreed that all students must complete MMs or the assessment process is incomplete. The following solutions were discussed: use a paper version of MMs or withhold placement results until all students have completed MMs. D. Beydler has requested a copy of CAI MM questions and is waiting for a response. There was concern that new test questions will be unable to feather out LERN 48 & 49 placements. 5.2 RIE will need a request submitted from SSSPAC to move forward with the follow up study on AWE MMs	 5.1 J.
