1. Verify Membership and Activity Assignment List	Team members reviewed and added members.	Updated list submitted to J. Ocampo
2. CCCAssess Implementation Team UPDATE	 2.1 N. Martinez attended the CAI Update in San Diego and offered the following details: 8,000 pilot tests have been given so far. One problem was that students did not know their CCCID. It's taking up to 3.5 hours for the English test only. The ultimate goal is for the English and Math combined to take 3.5 hours. The MM instrument can be customized, which means that colleges can add their own questions. 2.2 D. Beydler reported that in the most recent math subgroup meeting a statewide Test Reports Workgroup 	

- was formed. They will be developing a placement formula wizard into which we can put our placement formulas. David also added that various colleges who are implementing in the Fall are panicking because of the lack of information and the changing nature of the information.
- 2.3 Counseling brought up a concern about implementation in the spring: If the placement test is implemented in the middle of the term, there is the possibility that some high schools will receive the current placement test, and some high schools will receive the new test. This will impact the high school information sessions. J. Smith would like to request that we begin implementation of CAI during Winter 2017.
- 2.4 D. Miho reported that ESL writing will be combined with English writing, so there will be only one test. There are currently five testing sections of ten questions each. They will be working on the writing prompts this summer. She said that high school GPA and transcripts will be included in the multiple measures questions. For ESL writers, who generally do not have a high school GPA, different questions will need to be devised.
- 2.5 E Kaljumagi asserted that the implementation team must soon discuss what we want our MM model to be. We should include many factors, not just GPA and transcripts.
- 2.6 ABE/ESL want to request the ability to test in their buildings.
- 2.7 L. DeLeon reported that the grant application was submitted. The grant for \$15,000 supports the

	implementation of CAI. In addition to this grant, which will probably be funded, we have SSSP money for implementation. She asks that names be submitted from the different teams so that they can be submitted for approval. Then team members will be able to receive stipends for work on CAI. 2.8 M. Tsai noted that we will need to collect and review more data at intervals for years to check student success rates to assure accurate placement. 2.9 Team Lead Persons will need to get in touch with team members regarding summer meetings.
