4.0	2018-2019 Basic Skills Budget – Michelle Dougherty to present (confirmed)	Michelle presented the 2018-19 Basic Skills Funding Proposal – there were 13 requests submitted to total \$892,178. Projected allocation is \$1,179,309 with a potential carryover from 17-18 of \$437,097. This would leave a balance of \$151,226 for the 18-19 year. Tutoring is the largest allocation of \$245,575. Pathways to Transfer scaled down their request to only \$67,025. School of Continuing Education's Professional Development proposal is new for \$73,713.	Council members approved the Budget unanimously. The budget will move forward to the Academic Senate – full Senate for vote.
