The College shall include in its Annual Security Report a statement advising the campus community where information pertaining to registered sex offenders may be obtained.

Sex offenders are required to register with law enforcement in the jurisdiction in which they reside and with the campus police department of any institution of higher learning if they are students there or if they work there as employees, contractors, or volunteers. Sex offenders who are required to register in accordance with Penal Code Section 290.01 should do so at the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department station at 21695 East Valley Boulevard, Walnut, California.
