Chapter 6 - Business and Fiscal Affairs

AP 6350 Contracts – Construction

The College President/CEO or their designee shall be responsible for the planning and programming of new construction, alterations, and repairs of existing plants and leasing of facilities that require State approval. This includes the planning and programming of Collegeinitiated new construction, additions to existing plants, and major alterations and repairs of buildings and grounds.

The Executive Director of Facilities Planning and Management or their designee shall be responsible for preparation of drawings and specifications for new buildings, leased facilities, additions, major alterations, and improvements of buildings and grounds together with cost estimates.

The letting of contracts for construction shall comply with procedures of the College regarding contracts that exceed the statutory minimums for competitive bidding (see Administrative Procedure 6340).
