The Board of Trustees governs on behalf of the citizens of the Mt. San Antonio Community College District in accordance with the authority granted and duties defined in Education Code Section 70902.

The Board is committed to fulfilling its responsibilities to:

- Represent the public interest;
- Establish policies that define the institutional mission and set prudent, ethical and legal standards for college operations;
- Assure that the Board operates in an open, accessible, welcoming spirit and maintains an anti-racist culture;
- Establish policies that ensure the College operates in an anti-racist manner;
- Hire and evaluate the College President/CEO;
- Delegate power and authority to the College President/CEO to effectively lead the College;
- Assure fiscal health and stability;
- Monitor institutional performance and educational quality; and
- Advocate for and protect the College.
