

Chapter 2 – Board of Trustees

BP 2365 Recording

Government Code Sections 7920.0000 et seq., 54953.5, and 54953.6; Education Code Section 72121(a)

Any audio or video recording of an open and public Board Meeting made by or at the direction of the Board shall be subject to inspection by members of the public in accordance with the California Public Records Act, Government Code Sections 7920.000 et seq.

The President/CEO is directed to enact administrative procedures to ensure that any such video recordings are maintained for 30 days, and any such audio recordings are maintained for at least three years following the taping or recording.

Persons attending an open and public meeting of the Board may, at their own expense, record the proceedings with an audio or video tape recording or a still or motion picture camera or may broadcast the proceedings. However, if the Board finds by a majority vote that the recording or broadcast cannot continue without noise, illumination, or obstruction of view that constitutes or would constitute a persistent disruption of the proceedings, any such person shall be directed by the President of the Board to stop.
