Chapter 6 – Business and Fiscal Affairs

BP 6530 Closed-Circuit Television Surveillance Systems

Reference:

California Penal Code, Sections 630-637.9

The College President/CEO shall establish procedures necessary to implement closed circuit television (CCTV) surveillance systems throughout the campus as such need may arise. The implementation of such systems shall be solely for the protection of District property and assets from theft and vandalism through deterrence and video documentation. The CCTV system is not designed or intended to protect individuals from being victims of violent or property crimes, or to detect other potentially illegal or undesirable activities which may occur although any video information obtained by such methods may be used as evidence in such cases.

The implementation of closed circuit television camera systems shall not be utilized to monitor areas where persons have a reasonable expectation of privacy.

The implementation of closed circuit television camera systems shall not replace the need for supervision/public safety staff. Administrators and public safety staff shall ensure that due diligence is observed in maintaining general campus security.

The CCTV system shall not be represented at any time as enhancing or ensuring the personal safety of any individual under any circumstances:
