Program Outcome Reporting Resolution – Passed unanimously, May 16, 2013, by the Academic Senate March 2013

To sustain the transparency requirements of Academic Senate Resolution 2009-02, as well as to ensure compliance with the expectations of the ACCJC, the Outcomes Committee recommends that the college host reports on the Outcomes website that detail progress towards program-level SLOs.

The proposed reports would be an enhancement over the current publicly available data found at http://slo.mtsac.edu in that the website currently lists just the program outcome for each degree or certificate. The type and format of the proposed reports would be similar to the examples below, and remains a subset of the data currently available to students and faculty via the my.mtsac.edu portal.

The Outcomes Committee agrees that adding reports of this nature to the college's website will ensure compliance with ACCJC requirements.
