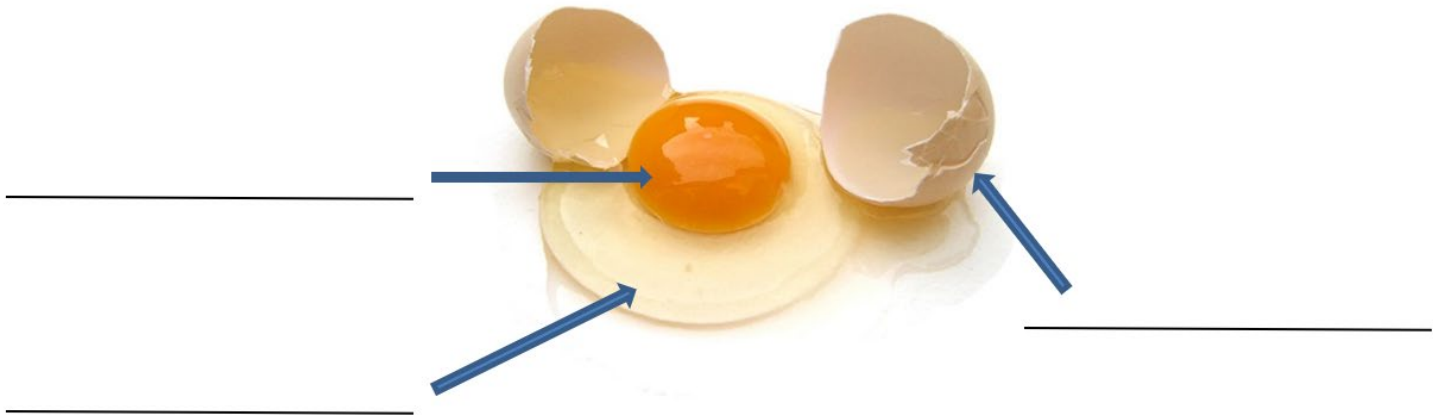
Section 1: Introduction

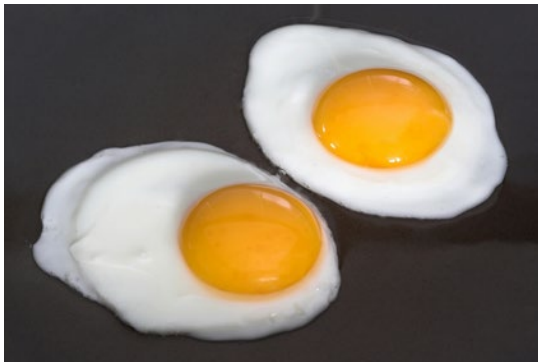
