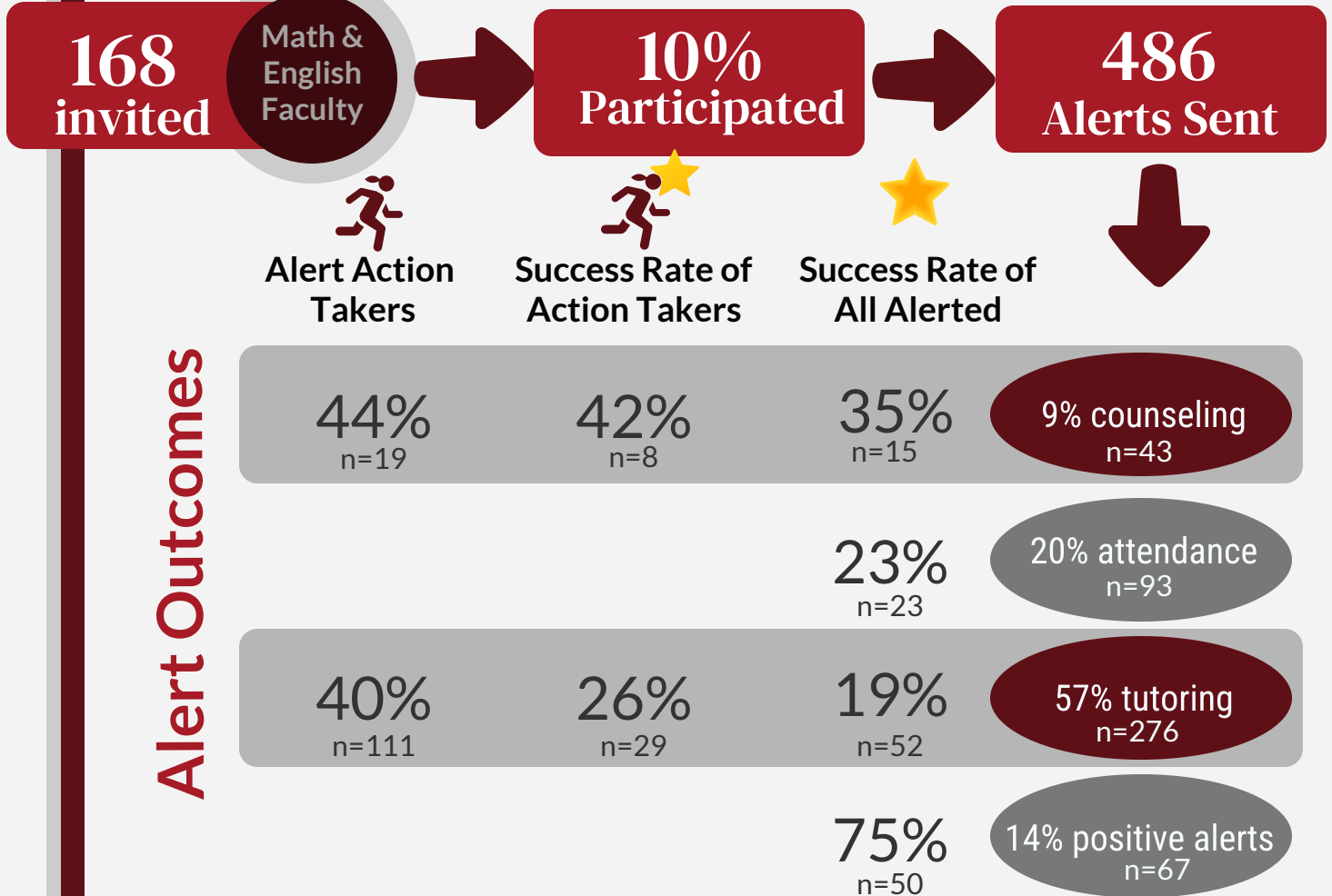


# Navigate Campaign Outcomes

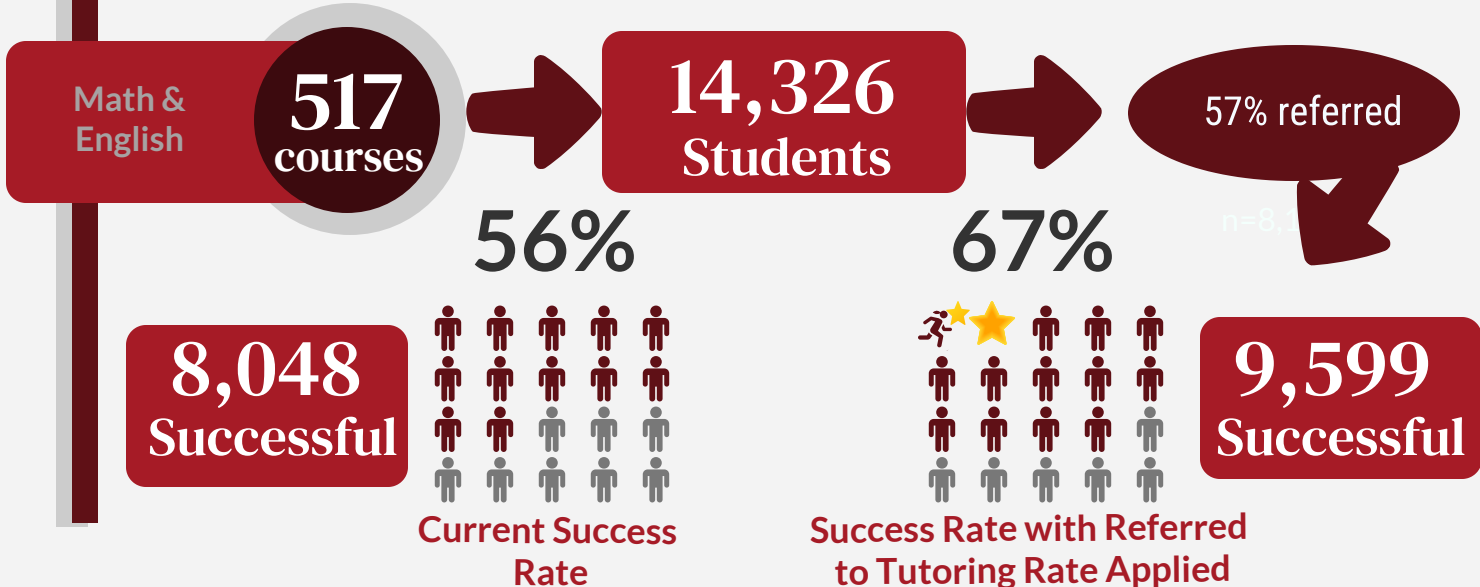
Fall 2022



During the fall 2022 term all math and English faculty were invited to participate in the Navigate alert system. Of the 168 faculty invited, 16 or 10% created alerts for their students. This resulted in 486 alerts being issued to 352 students.
