Co-curricular engagement refers to "activities, programs, and learning experiences that complement, in some way, what students are learning in school – i.e., experiences that are connected to or mirror the academic curriculum" (Great Schools Partnership, 2013, as cited in Stirling & Kerr, 2015). Students attending the 102<sup>nd</sup> annual Western Psychological Association (WPA) convention will be exposed to research in the field of psychology presented by faculty and professionals, as well as graduate and undergraduate students. By nature of the event, attendance will surely enhance and complement the learning taking place in the classroom. In addition, psychology students often go on to graduate school, and research experience is a requirement. All of the students attending will be presenting research they have completed as Mt. SAC students. In addition, they will be exposed to research currently taking place at colleges and universities in the Western region of the U.S. They will be encouraged to make connections and network with fellow students, faculty, and professionals in the field. Attending an event like WPA definitely increases interest and engagement, and thus increases retention and transfer success in students who attend.
