Financial Aid

There are many forms of aid available:

Fee Waiver

California Community College Promise Grant (Formally known as the BOG Fee Waiver) - waives your enrollment fees.

Grants – As long as you complete your classes they do not need to be paid back!

Pell Grant = Money from the Federal Government

Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG) = Money from the Federal Government

Cal Grant = Money from the California Government

Chaffey Grant = Money for former foster youth*

*To apply you must submit a financial aid application and an additional application

Additional Forms of Aid

Scholarships:

Scholarships = Free money from organizations or donors
 (You need to apply for scholarships separately from the other kinds of financial aid listed here)
