The VRC consists of: _

- 3 Private Offices
- Intake Counter that seats 3 staff
- Kitchen (with sink, fridge, Industrial Keurig, microwave and dishwasher)
- Peer Mentoring Space
- · Lounge with a Reserve Library
- Flat Screen and Movie Library
- Study Space
- Presentation Space
- Outdoor patio and seating area
- Access to 45 seat computer lab

The VRC is designed as a "one-stop-shop"

for Veterans GI Bill Processing and wraparound support services/programs that include:

- Priority Registration Processing
- VA Educational Benefits assistance
