

Chapter 4 – Academic Affairs

AP 4250 Probation

Title 5 Sections 55030, 55031, 55032, 55033, 55034

Notification of Probation: Each student will be notified of their academic probation or progress probation and the availability of College support services before the student is dismissed.

Notification will consist, at a minimum, of the following:

- At the end of the semester in which the student's cumulative Mt. SAC grade point average falls below 2.0, a notice shall be sent to the student informing them that they are on academic probation.
- At the end of the semester in which the student's percentage of all enrolled units for which entries of "W," "I," "NC," "NP," and/or "NPV" are recorded reaches or exceeds fifty percent (50%), a notice shall be sent to the student informing them that they are on progress probation.

Restriction on Enrollment: Upon recording of probation, students shall have their registration restricted, be required to participate in a prescribed counseling intervention, and be limited to enroll in a maximum of 12 units in subsequent semesters and 4 units in subsequent Winter and Summer intersessions while on probation.

For the purposes of this section, semesters shall be considered consecutive on the basis of the student's enrollment, so long as the break in the student's enrollment does not exceed one primary term (intersessions do not count towards this limit).
